APPRAISAL - The estimate of a disinterested qualified professional as to the current market value of a property. The term also refers to the report that sets forth the estimate.

CLOSING - The meeting of all concerned parties in order to transfer title. The date when the buyer takes title of the property.

CLOSING COSTS - Various fees and expenses, not including the price of the home, payable by the seller and the buyer at the time of a real estate closing. (E.g. brokerage commissions, title, etc.)

COMMISSION - The payment given a real estate broker for his or her services. Commission is usually paid at closing.

OFFER - A written proposal to buy a piece of property.

CONTRACT - An agreement between two parties. To be valid, a contract must be dated; must be in writing; and must include a consideration, a description of the property, the place and date of delivery of the deed, and all terms and conditions that were mutually agreed upon. It must also be executed (signed) by all concerned parties.

DEED - A written instrument that conveys title to property.

ESCROW - Money or documents held by a third party until specific conditions of an agreement or contract are fulfilled. The earnest money paid by the buyer with the signing of the contract is usually held in escrow until all contingencies in the contract are met.

FORECLOSURE - A proceeding to extinguish all rights, title, and interest of the owner(s) of property in order to sell the property to satisfy a lien against it.

LEASE - A contract that allows one party the possession of real estate for a specific period of time in return for a consideration (usually rent) paid to the other party.

LIEN - A recorded notice that there is a debt on a piece of property.

MARKET VALUE - Generally accepted as the best price that a ready, willing, and able buyer will pay, and the lowest price a ready, willing, and able seller will accept.

MORTGAGE - A legal document that creates a lien upon a piece of property.
